## VILLAGE OF BETHUNE SIGNING POLICY

The following shall be used in determining the requirements for signs to be erected in the Village of Bethune Signing Corridor located on the SW 19-20-24 W2 and SE 26-20-24 W2 along Highway 11.

- 1) Application to erect business or non-profit organization sign in signing corridor must be submitted to the Council of the Village of Bethune for approval.
- Applications approved by Council may be subject to further approval or further agreement with land owner where the signing corridor is located.
- The land owner has right of refusal or to charge a fee for each sign. Any fees the landowner may charge shall be the responsibility of the sign owner to compensate the land owner in a timely manner.
- 4) Any fees that may be charged for utilizing the signing corridor shall he collected by the Village of Bethune and forwarded to the land owner or to any other third party as directed by the land owner via a formal agreement.
- 5) The Fee for utilizing the Signing Corridor is \$100.00 per sign.for business and non-profit organizations.
- 6) In accordance with <u>The Erection of Signs Adjacent to Provincial Highways Regulations</u>, signs are to be located approximately 44 m from the center line of Highway #11 and within the signing corridor boundary as established by Saskatchewan Highways and Transportation.
- 7) In accordance with <u>The Erection of Signs Adjacent to Provincial Highways</u>
  <u>Regulations</u>, the distance between each sign in *the* corridor shall be in accordance to distances noted in the Private Signing Adjacent to Provincial Highways policy of Saskatchewan Highways and Transportation.
- Authorized signs permitted in signing corridor shall be either 2.43m in vertical x 3.6576 m horizontal or 1.8288 in vertical x 2.43 m horizontal, in size. Each corridor will allow for 4 2.43m in vertical x 3.6576 m horizontal and 8 1.8288 in vertical x 2.43 m horizontal signs.
- 9) The back of each sign shall be white in color.
- 10) Sign Supports made of 3" iron tubing or 4" x 4" treated wooden posts and shall be painted white.
- 11) The sign base shall be set at a maximum of 1.82 m above ground level.
- 12) The business or non-profit organization erecting a sign shall be responsible for all costs associated with sign fabrication, erection and maintenance of signs.
- 13) Signs shall be maintained annually by businesses and non-profit organizations to ensure signs are keep appealing and up to date. Signs not maintained adequately will be removed by the Village of Bethune.
- 14) Illumination of signs in the signing corridor may not be permitted.
