## **BYLAW NO. 9/2006**

## A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Village of Bethune, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Village of Bethune.
- 3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
- a. In the case of on individual, to a fine not exceeding \$2,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$500.00 for each day during which the offence continues; and
- b. In the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further find not exceeding \$1500 for each day during which the offence continues.
