

Snow Removal During the Winter Season

Main roads and high-traffic routes are prioritized for snow clearing in all areas followed by secondary roads. Please slow down when passing or approaching snow clearing machinery. When clearing private driveways and walkways, please do not place snow on roads, alleyways or on neighbouring properties.

You Can Help with Snow Removal

- Please refrain from blowing your property's snow onto the street or alley, especially after the streets have been cleaned.
- If you are concerned about your driveway being accidentally blocked with snow from the tractor at the time of clearing, please contact the Village office
- After a snowfall, please remove vehicles from the street so that the snow removal equipment can clean the area effectively. Otherwise, the vehicles will become blocked with snow, and the Village will not be held responsible for this inconvenience.

Residents and businesses are cordially requested to clear snow & ice from sidewalks adjacent to their properties within 24 hours of a snowfall.

2021 – Assessment Revaluation Year

A reminder that 2021 is a reassessment year in the province of Saskatchewan. The Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) will be updating property valuations to reflect a base rate of January 1, 2019. The preliminary 2021 assessment information will be provided to the Village office early January 2021. Once it is received it will be reviewed by the Council and information on the impacts of the 2021 Revaluation will be sent out to ratepayers in early first quarter of 2021.

Please remember to keep your vehicles and properties locked.
