

BYLAW NO. 2/96

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BETHUNE
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, FOR
THE RESTRICTION OF CHEMICAL SPRAY EQUIPMENT**

The Council of the Village of Bethune, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Chemical Spray Equipment Bylaw.
2. No person shall operate or park agricultural or commercial type chemical spray equipment in the Village of Bethune.
3. The owner or operator shall not fill any spray equipment at the Village of Bethune water plant (tank loading facility).
4. The owner or operator of chemical spray equipment found operating or parking same in violation of this bylaw may be liable up to a fine of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars.
5. This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
6. Bylaw No. 3/86.... is hereby repealed.
