

BYLAW NO. 12/2005

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BETHUNE
TO PROVIDE FOR THE PREVENTION
OF FIRES**

WHEREAS subsection 141(2)(b) of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* provides that a council may, by bylaw, Prohibit, Regulate, Control or require the incineration of solid waste or refuse of any defined class.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BETHUNE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Open flames whose quantity and method of use create a fire hazard shall not be permitted.
2. Open air fires are allowed in firepits, fireplaces, grills or barbeques which are designed, constructed and maintained in conformance with good engineering practices.
3. No person shall burn the following materials in an open air fire:
 - a) waste including rubbish, garbage, garden refuse or scrap;
 - b) any dangerous good or hazardous waste;
 - c) any material that generates black smoke
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction, shall be liable to the Penalty provided for by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality, Bylaw #1/87.
